



HOW CAN YOU HELP?

- Be careful what you put down the drain. Bug killer, paint thinner and other chemicals are difficult for treatment plants to remove.
- Take short showers or shallow baths.
- Make sure to turn the tap off completely. One tap dripping twice a second will send over 50 gallons of clean water to the treatment plant each week.
- Turn off the water while you're brushing your teeth, washing your hands, or washing the car.
- Do not pour grease down the drains.
- Do not put prescription drugs down the drain.

DO NOT FLUSH THESE ITEMS:

Dental Floss, Non-flushable Wipes, Flushable Wipes, Baby Diapers, Adult Incontinence Protectors (i.e. Depends), Feminine Hygiene Products, Condoms, Paper Towels, Shop Towels, Fat, Grease, Oils, Garbage Disposals Fatty - Greasy Waste

Ideally, the sewer should handle only human waste, toilet paper and water.
